IMPORTANT NOTE

1. The applicant must take due care while filling up the form (online). The information provided by the applicant in his/her form shall not be changed or altered in any case and the University will not entertain such requests under any circumstance. The University shall not be liable for any mistake made by the applicant.
2. In case if the number of registered candidates at any of the examination centres is less than 100 (One Hundred), then in such case the registered candidates will be allotted the nearest centre.
3. There is no provision of revaluation/scrutiny.
4. Only such RTI applications shall be entertained which are received within 60 days from the declaration of final result.
5. Each candidate will also have to mention his / her Sub-Category along with his / her overall category i.e. UR, SC, ST and OBC.
6. To give the benefit to students who have passed the eligibility examination in the current year 2018-19 a deduction of 5% marks would be made for every gap year from the obtained marks. The maximum deduction would be 15%.
7. Every candidate will have to declare any disciplinary action/police action against him.
8. The Registration Fees for General and OBC Category is Rs. 1600/- and SC/ST/PH is Rs. 800/-.
9. Every candidate can view his/her Answer Sheet within one month of declaration of Results by paying a token amount Rs. 100/- at Pravesh Bhawan.

1. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

The minimum qualification for admission to the MBA programme shall be graduation from a recognized Institution (Degree Course of at least three years duration with separate annual/semester examination system) from any stream. Students appearing in the final year examination of the undergraduate class are also be permitted to apply, subject to the condition that they furnish their final graduation pass result not later than the date of admission.

2. NO. OF SEATS

After implementation of reservation for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) total 57 seats in MONIRBA and 57 seats in GBPSSI are available. (the seats may be change as per HRD recommendations)

3. RESERVATION AND SPECIAL CONSIDERATION / QUOTA:

- A. In accordance with provision of Section 9 of the University of Allahabad Act, 2005 (Act No. 26 of 2005) seats shall be reserved for Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST) and Other Backward Classes (OBC) category candidates in all subjects / course for which the Admission Test has been held, as given here under:
- 15% of the total seats in each subject / course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC) category;
 - 7.5% of the total seats in each subject / course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe (ST) category; and
 - 27% of the total seats in each subject / course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Other Backward Caste (OBC) category.
 - In case the seats reserved for Scheduled Tribe (ST) category candidates remain vacant on account of non-availability of candidates the same shall be filled by the candidates of Scheduled Caste (SC) candidates.
 - Subject to any order from NCTE, 25% seats may be increased for admission under Economically Weaker Section (EWS) quota. 10% of the total seats shall be reserved for candidate belonging to EWS category. Reservation to EWS candidates shall be given by the University as per Govt. of India guidelines, the regulation/norms issued by the UGC and subject to any decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India or Hon'ble Hihg Court of Allahabad, if any.

Note: These rules are indicative and UGC Regulation on Reservation as on the date of declaration of Results shall be followed.

B. Kashmiri Migrants:

Weightage as per Government of India guidelines shall be given to Kashmiri Migrants. In order to avail this weightage, the candidates shall have to present a certificate to this effect from an officer of the Ministry of Human Resource Development not below the rank of Joint Secretary or equivalent.



C. Foreign Nationals/NRI:

Foreign Nationals shall be required to apply through International Students Advisor in accordance with the procedure laid down by the University of Allahabad. The candidate in this case shall not be required to appear in the Admission Test / Entrance Test, but shall be considered for admission on the recommendation of a committee constituted for the purpose, which shall examine the academic credentials and certificates of the candidate before making any recommendation.

D. Person with Disability (Divyang):

- (i) As per section 32(1) of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, all Government institutions of higher education and other higher education institutions receiving aid from the Government shall reserve not less than **five(05) per cent** seats for person with benchmark disabilities. Therefore 5% of total seats for this course will be available for person with disability who can pursue this course without any difficulty.
- (ii) A candidate who has a certified disability of not less than 40 % in any limb or in orthopaedic structure which, in the opinion of the Medical Board (constituted by the University of Allahabad), amounts to an overall physical handicap of not more than 70% or is a certified Visually impaired or a Hearing impaired, may be admitted to the concerned course / subject, irrespective of his position in the order of merit of the total aggregate score, on the recommendation of the Medical Board.
- (iii) Seats under this quota shall be filled in order of preference given below. One percent each shall be reserved for person with benchmark disability under clause (a), (b) and (c), and one percent with benchmark disability under clauses (d) and (e) namely.
 - a. Blindness and low vision.
 - b. Deaf and hard of hearing.
 - c. Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy.
 - d. Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness.
 - e. Multiple disabilities from amongst person from clauses (a) to (d).
- (iv) The privilege shall not be given except claimed by the candidate at the time of application. At the time of admission the candidate shall be required to produce a certificate issued by the Chief Medical Officer of the appropriate District or by the Viklang Kendra, Allahabad, which testifies to his disability and bears an attested photograph indicating his / her disability clearly.
- (v) All candidates entitled to be admitted under the above quota to a course shall be adjusted against their respective social category.

E. Teacher/Employee Ward Quota:

After the completion of admission on the sanctioned seats in each course of study, the wife, sons and daughters of regularly appointed serving and retired teachers/employee of the University, the University Institutes, the constituents Colleges and constituents Institutes, who produce relevant certificate duly signed by the Registrar in case of University, the Director in case of University Institutes, the Principal in the case of constituent Colleges and the Director



in case of constituent Institutes shall be admitted, on the basis of their relative scores against 5% supernumerary seats (with a minimum of one seat) in each course of study, only in the unit/sub-unit in which such Teachers/Employees are serving or where from they have superannuated.

Provided that if in case seats remain vacant in a course in the unit/subunit, these will be filled by the wards of the employees of other units/subunits and words of contractual and daily wage employees of the University, University Institutes, the Centers thereof and the independent Centers.

Note-Teacher/Employee Ward benefit will be granted only when the candidate has made such a claim in the Application Form and presents the required documents and certificates at the time of admission. The order of merit for admission shall be determined on the basis of computed marks of the candidate.

- **No weightage shall be given for NCC/NSS. No seats are available under Sports quota.**

FOREIGN STUDENTS

Admission of foreign nationals shall be made strictly as per recommendations of the Foreign Students Advisor of the University as supernumerary seats. Foreign students recommended from time to time by the Government of India shall be exempted from Admission Test.

REQUIREMENT TO APPEAR FOR ADMISSION TEST

All applicants, except the foreign national applicants applying through the prescribed channel shall have to appear in the Admission Test.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The admission to the MBA course shall be based on Admission Test comprising of Written and Oral Tests (Group Discussion & Personal Interview). All tests shall be conducted only in English medium.

WRITTEN TESTS (300 MARKS):

The written tests shall judge applicants for proficiency in written communication, intelligence, propensity to observe facts and use them, propensity to grasp and use quantitative and scientific tools, general awareness, logical thinking, reasoning power, aptitude for management learning and practice, and maturity in terms of personality.

(i) Communication Ability in English	40 questions	80 Marks
(ii) Aptitude and Reasoning	40 questions	80 Marks
(iii) General Awareness	40 questions	80 Marks
(iv) Quantitative Aptitude	30 questions	60 Marks
Total	150 question	300 Marks

Note: - Admission Test shall be held through Online Mode only at the centre allotted by the University on the Admit Card.



Qualification for GD & PI :

The number of candidates to be called for GD and PI Test shall be three times the number of Seats in the MONIRBA for MBA and GBPSSI for MBA-RD.

Group Discussion (50 Marks)

Group leadership test shall be done by grouping the applicants in viable groups and conducting discussion on chosen themes to test the applicant's leadership ability, group behaviour, and adjustment with group dynamics.

Personal Interview (50 Marks)

Personal Interview will be held for each candidate separately to test overall suitability of a candidate for doing M.B.A.

FINAL LIST OF SELECTED CANDIDATES:

The final list of selected candidates shall be drawn on the basis of the overall performance of the candidates in the Written and GD & PI Tests. Every candidate has to appear in all Written Tests and GD & PI Tests. Thus, a candidate, who is, for whatsoever reason, does not present himself in any of the above Test(s) shall not be considered for final admission. Final result shall be declared on the official website of University of Allahabad and displayed on the notice board of MONIRBA and GBPSSI.

If the score of two or more candidates is identical in overall, Admission Test, Admission shall be granted on the following basis :

- Score in the Written Test.
- Percentage Marks scored in Graduate Examination, in case of score in written test is also identical,
- By drawing a lottery. If the marks in Graduate Examination are same.

A student after being declared successful must deposit his fees with in stipulated timing if a student does not collect his/her Intimation Card or deposit the fee by the required date he/she the candidate next in merit will be given admission.

TEST CENTRES

The written test shall be held at Prayagraj, Jhansi, Bangalore, Gorakhpur, Kanpur, Kolkata, Lucknow, New Delhi, Thiruvantpuram and Varansai.–The candidate shall have the option to appear from any one of the specified centers. In case the number of applicants opting for a centre is less than 100, the University shall have the right to cancel that centre and direct the candidates to appear in any nearest centre registered by them in their application forms or as decided by the University. The Group Discussion/Personal Interview for the short-listed candidates shall be conducted only at Prayagraj. The Candidates shall have to make their own arrangements for travel and stay for appearing in the written and oral tests and shall not be entitled to any TA/DA.
